It makes an accurate reading of the pastoral situation in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic. Since March 2020 we have all become accustomed to hearing and repeating that the world has changed and will never be the same again.

On a Christian (but not only Christian) level, the image of Pope Francis praying alone in the empty St. Peter's Square on the rainy afternoon of March 28, 2020, will be hard to forget as one of the iconic and "viral" images of this global crisis.

Youth ministry cannot remain the same in its methods and actions during and after this pandemic. "I sincerely believe (says the author) that the proposals of

The author of this book wants to answer the question about the specifics of the life consecrated to God. After pointing out that the transformations in religious life are not only due to an internal dynamism of the Spirit, but also to the inevitable pressure of the social cultural context, we note that what is at issue is a new articulation of that spiritual experience that gives rise to and sustains religious life, lived in the heart of modernity, a modernity that, at the very least, is no longer professed to be Christian.

If the reflection contained in this volume would like to show anything, it is that consecrated life, as it has been – and continues to be – thought of and regulated by the Church today, is insufficiently founded on the Gospel. Here lies the root of their deep discomfort. And also, without ignoring his evident achievements, the cause of the poverty of his testimony.



The stories found in this book are designed for the catechesis of confirmation groups, post-confirmation and youth groups, but they can also be used for other formation meetings.

The literary genre of short stories is characterized by liking different audiences, arousing stimuli and open points of reflection. Each reader looks at a particular detail, and, through this, various moments of his life, of his relationship with those around him and with God are revealed. We can say that stories are an invitation to dream, to learn, to experience emotions, and, finally, they help to read life in the light of God and Christian values. These stories seek to break the ice in the rich dialogue that has to mediate in our Christian groups, so that together we are heading towards who the Truth is, Christ.

In each of the 23 stories the author proposes this scheme: a list of values that he suggests in each story; a biblical text; some Augustinian texts; the story it proposes; suggestions for group work.

At the top of the Mount of Olives, very close to the road that formerly linked Bethany with the village of Bethphage and with the city of Jerusalem, there is a cave in which, according to tradition, Jesus used to retire to pray. In addition to visiting the cave, pilgrims can tour today the space of what was to be the Basilica Eleona, created by Santa Elena, precisely to preserve that cave. And you can also see the multitude of tiles embedded in the cloisters of the carmelite monastery, in which the Lord's Prayer can be read in many languages and dialects. In that scenario it is easy to wonder about the origin and meaning of that prayer that sums up the Christian spirit.

As with its twin Commentary on the Apostles' Creed (2019), also published in EDITORIAL CCS, this book is not intended to add a surprising explanation for its novelty about the petitions we find in the Lord's Prayer. We only try to offer some simple schemes that are understandable both for catechists and for


